ADMISSION NOTICE

Public Sector Medical and Dental Colleges Session 2021-22

Shaheed Zulfiqar Ali Bhutto Medical University, Islamabad being the Admitting University invites application for admission in First Year, Bachelor of Medicine & Surgery (MBBS) and Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS) program, in the following Public Sector Medical and Dental Colleges under the Administrative Control of Federal Government.

Medical Institutes	Dental Institute
1- Federal Medical College, Islamabad	1- School of Dentistry, Islamabad

- The allotted seats for quota in respective medical/dental colleges is available on the website i.e. www.szabmu.edu.pk
- Applicants desirous for admission against subject quota need to submit a document issued by concerned authority certifying that applicant is eligible against the quota i.e. domicile certificate, Federal Government Employees Certificate, disability certificate.
- The candidates applying on the basis of domicile will have to provide, in addition to domicile certificate, proof of residence/property/education or any tangible evidence of stay in region of domicile.

Eligibility Criteria:

In accordance with "PMC Medical and Dental Undergraduate Education (Admission, Curriculum and Conduct) Regulation 2021-(Amended)" and "PMC conduct of Examinations Regulations 2021" of Pakistan Medical Commission, the basic eligibility criteria for admissions are as follows:

- Minimum 65% (715/1100) marks, in HSSC Pre-Medical or A-Level Equivalent, duly certified by the Inter-Board Committee of Chairmen (IBCC) AND
- Minimum 65% marks in National MDCAT conducted by Pakistan Medical Commission (PMC).

Admission Procedure:

- The applicants are required to visit SZABMU Website www.szabmu.edu.pk and click the link '**Admissions in Public Sector Medical & Dental colleges**'.
- The application process shall be completely online and no manual or paper-based application shall be accepted.
- Only completed and submitted online application will be considered for the admissions.
- For filling the online application form, the candidate shall first register on the web portal with the help of his/her CNIC/Passport, e-mail ID and a password.
- After registration, applicant is required to complete the online application form requiring the following steps
 - Personal Information
 - National MDCAT Information
 - Academic Information
 - Applicants will take print of application processing fee challan from online admission portal and deposit at nearest branch of Habib Bank Ltd.
 - Upload Scanned Copies of documents
 - Candidate shall have to apply separately for medical or dental program
- Application processing fee is Rs. 3,000/- which is non-refundable/non-adjustable
- Once applicant is offered admission according to his/her merit and quota, it will be final and will not be changed.
- The application form once submitted cannot be changed by the applicant.
- Candidates applying on the basis of last year National MDCAT 2020 is required to upload equivalence issued by PMC.

Mandatory Documents Required:

(A) For All:

- i. Recent Passport size color photograph of the candidate with blue background.
- ii. Valid CNIC/CRC/NICOP of the candidate
- iii. HSSC Pre-Medical Certificate issued by concerned board /Equivalence Certificate of A-Level/12th Grade issued by IBCC. The candidates having foreign qualification shall also upload their original results issued by concerned foreign University/High School/Board and showing his/her subjects.
- iv. HSSC Pre-Medical Transcript/A-Level/12th Grade Transcript.
- v. The candidates having foreign qualification (A-Level, 12th Grade etc.) shall submit a letter of Equivalence of Grades in Science Electives of Biology, Chemistry and Physics/Mathematics issued separately by IBCC. This is mandatory, according to the directions of Pakistan Medical Commission (PMC). Only the marks obtained in the HSSC/ Equivalence Science electives of Biology, Chemistry and Physics/Mathematics shall be used.
- vi. Domicile Certificate of the candidate.
- vii. Hifz-e-Quran certificate issued by the registered Madrasa with Wafaq ul Madaris.
- viii. PMC MDCAT 2021 Result Certificate / MDCAT 2020 Equivalence Result.

(B) Additional Mandatory Documents for Foreign Seats:

- i. Foreign student means a student who is not a Pakistani Student and holds only a foreign nationality.
- ii. Current valid foreign passport of the candidate.

(C) Additional Mandatory Documents for Quota:

- i. Disability Certificate issued by a specialist working in a Federal/Provisional Government Hospital Disability Board describing the nature of disability (For seats of disabled quota only).
- ii. Employment certificate issued by relevant Federal Government Institution (For seats of Federal Govt. Employees only).

As per PMC Guidelines Special Provision for Students with Delayed F.Sc. Or ALevel Results:

- Any student who has applied for admissions but their F.Sc or A Level result is delayed due to late exams shall be considered for admission subject to such result being available prior to 10th February 2022.
- A college shall retain a list of all such students and an equal number of seats from the bottom of the allocated seats shall be held on a provisional basis.
- Students who have applied with their results available shall be admitted on a Provisional Basis only on such seats till 10th February 2022.
- If a student with a delayed result submits their result before 10th February, 2022 and on calculation is higher in merit than the last student on the admitted list, they shall be given admission and the provisional admission to the earlier student shall be cancelled. A student who has paid the fee against a provisional admission shall be have their fee refunded in full.
- If no candidate with delayed results submits before 10th February 2022, the provisional admissions shall be finalized.

Important Instructions:

- i. The entire process of submission of application is online; hence, there is no need to submit hard copy of application to the University.
- ii. It should be noted that any applicant who does not meet the eligibility criteria will not be considered for admission.
- iii. Candidates claiming to be Hifz-e-Quran must upload the scanned Hifz Certificate issued by the registered Madrasa with Wafaq ul Madaris. The candidate shall have to appear for Hifz-e-Quran test conducted by SZABMU.
- iv. Incomplete/deficient applications shall not be entertained.
- v. Application once submitted shall be considered final.
- vi. Original scan documents to be uploaded in JPEG, JPG or PNG format only and file size should not exceed 512KB per document.
- vii. The selected applicant shall have to deposit their fee after securing position in merit list within due date, failing which the provisional admission will be deemed cancelled and the next applicant on the waiting merit list will be offered admission in order to facilitate timely completion of admission process.
- viii. The University shall cancel any provisional admission where the credentials of a student are not verified.
- ix. **A student who is found to have forged their high school leaving certificate / degree or presented a false document shall be barred from applying to any medical or dental college in Pakistan in the future and the admission of the candidate shall stand cancelled.**
- x. No separate call letters will be issued for interviews/placement etc. All such information will be available on the official website of SZABMU www.szabmu.edu.pk till the completion of admission process.
